Tim Boese, Manager, presented the FY 2012 budget for review and discussion. With the assessment rate of \$0.75, revenues and fund balance total \$587,314, and expenditures total \$395,526. The land assessment base total 701,155 acres and the water assessment totals 365,589 acre-feet.

A land assessment rate of \$0.05 per acre and water assessment rate of \$0.75 were proposed to fund the FY 2012 budget.

President Larry Jacob asked if the audience had any comments. There were none.

Moved by Fred Seiler and seconded by Dennis Gruenbacher to adjourn the hearing. Motion carried with 6 Directors for, 0 Directors against, 0 Directors abstained, and 3 Directors absent.
